Our time in Guatemala has been interrupted somewhat by Mac leaving for 3 weeks as he went home to be with his mom while she was in the hospital. She has been released and is responding well to her treatment. I remained in Guatemala.

This month was filled with our usual activities of Womens', Youth and now Children's Ministry. Amy Cordero is heading that up and the parents release their little ones into our care for an hour each week to sing, pray and hear the Word at the level they can understand it.

We also continue the adult education program for adults 15 and older at the elementary level. We are gearing up to add Junior High once again and now for the first time Senior High for adults. The elementary program has been a blessing to the community. we are excited to now to be able to provide Junior and Senior High for adults.

We now have 11 children graduating from elementary school who will need sponsors. There were 12 graduates from elementary school. Now there is one less because of suspected abuse in the family. She is no longer living in the area. Please remember her in your prayers and for her younger sister who is still living at home with her parents.

Graduation from Senior High 2016



Betzaida is one of the reasons we are doing a fundraiser to support children who want to study next year and to provide educational opportunities for all of the children we have seen grow from sometimes infancy to adulthood.

Fifteen of our students are in need of support for 2022. Eleven students are graduating from 6th grade and entering the 7th grade in 2022. We also have four 7th graders who need support to continue to study at the 8th grade level and one student who will be entering the 10th grade who needs a supporter.

In 2021 we lost some of our individual supporters of students due to Covid's economic stronghold but Bless the Lord there was always a special check sent or others who made a one time donation for education that covered any shortfall. Therefore I am letting you all know in advance what our shortfall is for 2022 and giving you an opportunity to participate.

Yearly support needed for each child is \$480 or \$40 a month starting in December or January 2022. Therefore we need \$7200 for all of them to continue to study. The yearly support of \$480 covers their internet, telephones and school materials because of their studying virtually. We also need to buy 15 telephones at a cost of \$125 each because those who were sharing in family are now attending other schools and their virtual classes don't coincide including the students graduating from elementary.

I thank you in advance for helping to break the cycle of poverty through education.
