


Isaiah 9:2. ESV The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; those who dwelt in a land of deep darkness, on them has light shone.


are our highest achievers in junior High, senior High and University. We are very proud of our students. Below is Denis who had a 88% average. He is in the 8th





Luis is in his 1st year in University studying radiology. He had a 81% average.






We are pleased to work together with other missionaries for the edification of the people in our community.
