We are in need of flooring, 6 fans, railing, exterior walls covering, screens for the windows, closets and shelves.

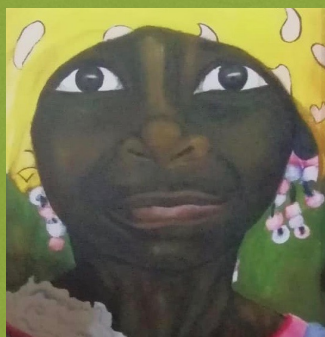
We are trusting God to provide our every need. He is faithful.
