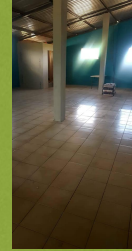
## Milk for health

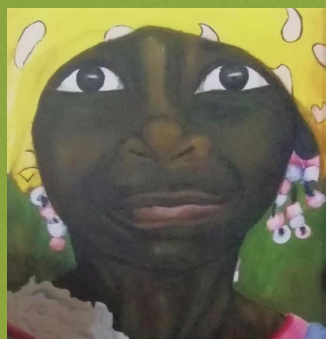
